

PRIVACY POLICY OF ASGARD.EVENTS WEBSITE

1. The website available at <http://asgard.events> (hereinafter referred to as the "Website") does not automatically collect any information, except for information voluntarily provided by its Users such as e-mail addresses and personal data as well as information contained in cookie files. The Users' e-mail addresses and personal data are not shared with any third parties. Each User has the right to request the Website to remove information provided by them.
2. Cookie files (the so called "cookies") are IT data, in particular text files, stored on the Website User's device for the purpose of using the Website's web pages. Cookies mainly contain the name of the web page of origin, time of storage on the User's device and an individual number.
3. Cookies are used to:
 - a) tailor the content of the Website's web pages to the User's preferences and optimize the use of such web pages; in particular, the cookie files make it possible to identify the Website User's device and properly display a web page, adapted to its individual needs;
 - b) create statistics allowing to understand the way the Website Users use the web pages, thus enabling the improvement of their structure and content;
 - c) maintain the Website User's session (after logging in) so that they do not need to re-enter their login and password on each web page of the Website.
4. The Website uses two basic types of cookie files: session cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are temporary files stored on the User's device until the User logs off, leaves a web page, or closes a software application (web browser). Persistent cookies are stored on the User's device for a specific time, which is defined by the file's parameters or until the file itself is deleted by the User.
5. In many cases software used for browsing of web pages (web browser) allows storing cookie files on the User's device by default. The Website Users may change cookie settings at any time. These settings can be changed in particular in such a way as to block the automatic handling of cookies in the web browser settings or inform the User every time cookies are stored on their device. Detailed information about the possibilities and ways of handling cookies is available in the settings of the software (web browser).
6. The operator of the Website informs that restricting the use of cookies may affect some of the functions available on the Website's web pages.
7. Cookies stored on the Website User's device may also be used by the advertisers and partners cooperating with the operator of the Website.
